

2. Background

2.1 The trip supports the State's Strategic policies of Growing Prosperity and Expanding Opportunity by promoting investment in education and industry; increased exports; inward investment; a business climate that encourages investment and economic growth.

3. Discussion

3.1 There will be a number of targeted business meetings with companies involved in mining, motor vehicles, defence, film making and media, business and skilled migration, public sector reform, education and infrastructure investment.

3.2 The Premier will also be a guest speaker at Carnegie Mellon.

3.3 The Premier will be accompanied by Mr Nick Alexandrides, Deputy Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Adviser, Office of the Premier and Ms Jill Bottrall, Principal Media Adviser, Office of the Premier. A delegation of seven journalists will also be accompanying the Premier.

3.4 Costs associated with the trip will be met from within existing budget allocations. Funds are available within the existing budget.


4. Recommendations

4.2 That Cabinet recommend Her Excellency the Governor in Executive Council appoints:

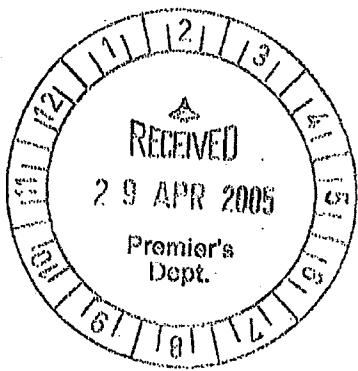
