- 1.2 That the Hon Paul Holloway MLC, Minister for Police, Minister for Mineral Resources Development and Minister for Urban Development and Planning be also appointed as Acting Premier, Acting Minister for Economic Development, Acting Minister for Social Inclusion, Acting Minister for the Arts and Acting Minister for Sustainability and Climate Change as well as Acting Deputy Premier, Acting Treasurer, Acting Minister for Industry and Trade, and Acting Minister for Federal/State Relations.

- 2.1 The Department of Trade and Economic Development has identified an opportunity for the Deputy Premier to meet with key officials from Mitsubishi in Japan, with the aim of seeking Mitsubishi's commitment to securing a future for the Mitsubishi Tonsley Plant.
